

# "Role of Pakistan in World Disarmament"

Only 9 countries in the whole world have kept the number of nuclear weapons more than 12950. So many weapons have the ability to destroy the entire earth including the universe. Akhand Bharat has become a small country today. There have been 24 partitions of Akhand Bharat in the last 2500 years. Spread over 83 lakh square kilometers, India has made a separate identity of its own. Today, due to the separation of Afghanistan, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Maldives and other Muslim nations, only 320,000 square kilometers are left. In this also, by infiltrating daily in Ladakh, Kashmir, Punjab and other areas by Pakistan, the grab policy is adopted. In this way, Islam is the fastest growing religion in the countries of the world. Afghanistan, which was the Gandhara of ancient India, is today a completely Islamic country.<sup>i</sup> It is estimated that by 2060, Islam will be the most powerful religion in the whole world. The reasons for not getting success of these efforts are that unity of thoughts of all the countries is not able to be formed. In 1968, under the Nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty, the Soviet Union and Britain, including America, presented the proposal of disarmament to the countries of the world. Presenting the fact by Pakistan at that time that this treaty is biased, hence it was not signed.

Failure to agree to this by Pakistan raises the apprehension that Pakistan will no longer stop the production and purchase of weapons<sup>iii</sup>. In the year 1994 (on January 14, 1994), when Ukraine, Russia and the United States signed an agreement that now arms reduction, production ban and purchase and sale should be cut, almost all Islamic nations at that time agreed to that agreement. This clearly means that Islamic countries never want the production and sale of weapons to stop. It is clear that Pakistan had the same attitude.

Pakistan has more or less officials of governance and administration, but there is a lot of soldiers and weapons. 620000 active army in which 500000 reserve soldiers are kept in Pakistan. Pakistan has more than 100 naval warships, 9 submarines, 8 frigates, 49 patrol vessels and 3 ships, 2 terminals, 2 coveys. It is a matter of thinking more than this that even today Pakistan has more atomic bombs than India.

This situation of Pakistan is a matter of concern for South Asian countries. There are many countries from Pakistan to Afghanistan, India, Nepal, China, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka etc. which keep on worrying. Not only this, today Pakistan is also a subject of challenge for America and Russia. America also wanted to stop Pakistan from making atomic bombs, but there was no special effect on Pakistan. India's two neighboring countries having more weapons than India's number of nuclear bombs is certainly worrying.<sup>iv</sup>
