- References, footnotes, tables, graphs, figures and maps must be properly cited.
- Citation and reference style as per journal publication guideline.
- Participants may also present their work in the form of a poster.

- Orientation: Portrait Maximum size: 1 m x 1 m
- Single sheet of material is recommended (not mandatory)
- Title and author(s) clearly at the top*, matching the submitted abstract Text, images, and diagrams must be clearly readable from 2 meter (about 6 ft)*

Notes: Participants must bring their printed poster to the venue. On-site poster printing will not be available. Double-sided tape, threads, and basic mounting materials will be provided. Double-sided tape, tacks and technical equipment will be available for the mounting of posters.
