# Innovative Techniques in Evaluation for vocabulary competence

- ✓ The used technique should be enable in making evaluation of so many steps along with exercising measurement.
- ✓ The technique should be more prevailing and valid.
- Practicality is that quality which indicates the feasibility for the general use of a test or evaluative techniques on such basis as cost, time required for administration, ease of administration, ease of scoring and ease of interpretation of the results.
- ✓ A norm provides an average or typical value for a measure or diagnosis obtained by the administration of measuring instrument to a specific population so that subsequent scores or measures for an individual or a group may be compared with the typical value of the normative population.
- ✓ Reliability is that quality which indicates the consistency, equivalency or stability of a measure that is obtained.
- ✓ Discrimination, Comprehensiveness and Economy should be taken in minds, which are congenial to the circumstances of our country.
